

Improving Waikanae Station

**From May 2010 Waikanae Station
will be under construction for up
to 7 months.**



When complete there will be:

-  A longer platform
-  A pedestrian crossing
-  A new station building
-  A second carpark

The station will remain open throughout construction although
parts of the platform and carpark will be blocked off at times.

STAGE 1: Build new carpark

We will start building the new carpark
off Pehi Kupa Street.

STAGE 2: Build half the new platform

You can use the southern platform while
we rebuild and extend the northern
platform. There will be a temporary
shelter as we need to remove the small
station building.

STAGE 3: Modify existing carpark

We'll make changes to the old carpark
to improve the flow of traffic. We'll wait
till the new carpark is open so there will
always be parks available.

STAGE 4: Build second half of the platform

You can use the new northern half of the
platform while we rebuild the southern
end. We will open a pedestrian crossing
to provide you with safer access
between the carpark and the station.

STAGE 5: Finishing details

Once the platform is open,
we'll still be working on the
carpark, and completing the
new station building.
