LINEHAUL LOGISTICS CO-ORDINATOR – TRAIN BUILD Integrated Operations Planning

Purpose:

The Linehaul Logistics Co-ordinator (Train Build Function), is responsible for building accurate mainline trains in a timely and professional manner, in order to provide relevant operational information to staff within both the Customer Service and Sales teams plus also communicating with yard staff across the various depots. You are responsible for monitoring mainline freight trains and shunts running within the system, auditing system information, and reporting any change in train make up within the relevant computer system.

This position involves shift work on a 24/7 rotating roster, which will include work over nights and weekends.

Health and Safety is an important part of how KiwiRail operates. You will be a safety leader and will be expected to "walk the safety talk"

Key Accountabilities

Train Assembly

- Building out-bound freight trains, including Metroport trains all trains are built and finalized within 20 minutes of receipt of operational information
- Building of Mainline Shunts
- Management of pull / place shunts
- Building passenger trains
- Validation of correct container association to wagon completed and correct wagons built to correct train
- Accurately enter information into relevant system

Operational Communication

- Providing train work order data to Locomotive Engineers
- Communication overload/ over length exceptions to Linehaul Service Managers
- Act as the end-of-process auditor for train departures with 100% of all exceptions reconciled within 30 minutes of train departure
- Work orders within 20 minutes of last call ensuring accurate, up to date information is always entered and provided
- Systems data is 100% reflective of physical train
- KPI boards 100% up-to-date prior to shift handover
- Review and respond to e mails and telephone calls from terminal staff and Customer Service Centre

Stakeholder contact

- Liaise with stakeholders (Customer Logistics team and yard staff) about changes to services or shunts
- Assess the customer's needs and plan ahead, taking into consideration all operational constraints
- Establish working relationships with a diverse range of people with a professional approach expected at all times
- 90% calls answered within 10 seconds
- Cargo reaches destination, on time, in full and in specification with 0% cargo handling errors due to process non - compliance and total cargo care philosophy practiced and fostered

Zero Harm

- Take an active role in identifying and reporting hazards/ emergency/ environmental incidents and unsafe behaviours in your workplace by reporting any hazards and incidents quickly

- Ensure your behaviour is consistent in taking the safety of yourself and others seriously
- Safety inductions in and around workplace are carried out ensuring procedure and processes are strictly followed (eg: Dangerous goods)
