About the Role

Purpose of the role

KiwiRail is in a phase of significant transformation to modernise and grow our rail and Interislander ferry services in Aotearoa.

The Supply Planner is responsible for developing the aggregate 36-month supply plan, assist in optimising operational performance, and collaborating across other departments to align all participating functions to the one aggregate supply plan. This position requires a combination of excellent analytical skills, supply chain knowledge, and strong communication abilities.

Key Accountabilities

Within the area of responsibility, this role is required to:

- Translate monthly demand forecasts into a corresponding aggregate supply plan for supply point leaders to assess their department's capabilities against the aggregate supply plan, highlighting operational changes, issues, risks, and opportunities.
- Ensure aggregate supply plans align with company policies and demand forecasts.
- Conduct scenario planning and risk assessments to enhance aggregate supply plan robustness.
- Analyse and interpret supply patterns and their business implications.
- Prepare and present regular reports on supply plans, capacity utilisation, and plan accuracy.
- Use data visualisation tools to communicate insights effectively.

Supply Planning	 Work with the Demand Planner / relevant stakeholders to convert the monthly demand forecasts into aggregate supply plans, along with changes, risks & opportunities, and scenarios. Collaborate with supply points to assess their capabilities against the aggregate supply plan, highlighting operational changes, issues, risks, and opportunities. Conduct scenario planning and risk assessments to enhance aggregate supply plan robustness. Create and update supply-side assumptions for the IBP process. Provide a copy of the validated, balanced aggregate IBP supply plan to the Integrated train planning team and relevant supply points. Communicate weekly with the Supply points and Integrated Train Planning team to ensure the aggregate supply plan is being met and consider operational change impacts.



Decision Making

Key decision-making requirements of the position include:

- Resolving conflicts between capacity constraints and demand forecasts
- Working with supply points to identify and mitigating risks in the supply chain.
- Adjusting plans in response to unforeseen disruptions or changes in demand.
