About the Role

Purpose of the role

KiwiRail is in a phase of significant transformation to modernise and grow our rail and Interislander ferry services in Aotearoa.

The Contract and Supplier Performance Manager oversees the end-to-end management of Wellington Metro's supplier contracts. The role ensures compliance with contractual obligations, drives supplier performance improvement, and manages relationship governance. A key responsibility is to ensure the Wellington Metro meets its performance obligations under the Wellington Network Agreement, aligning contract outcomes with agreed KPIs, and proactively addressing risks that could impact network performance.

Key Accountabilities

Within the area of responsibility, this role is required to:

- Ensure all contractual deliverables align with Wellington Metro's obligations under the Wellington Network Agreement.
- Ensure our contract records are accurate and correctly administered through KiwiRail's Contract Eagle system.
- Support the Commercial and Performance Manager by acting as a relationship manager for suppliers delivering services to Wellington Metro.
- Monitor supplier KPIs and SLAs, ensuring they support the Wellington Metro's performance targets.
- Lead regular supplier performance reviews in accordance with KiwiRail's supplier performance frameworks and implement improvement plans to address performance gaps.
- Proactively identify risks to meeting Wellington Network Agreement obligations and escalate or resolve issues promptly.
- Support external audits by acting as the coordinator for the wider Wellington Metro team.
- Collaborate with internal teams to ensure supplier activities contribute to achieving agreed reliability, availability, and service standards.
- Provide performance reporting to internal and external stakeholders, demonstrating compliance with contractual and network obligations.
- Serve as the key point of contact for suppliers, managing day-to-day queries, issue resolution, and escalation processes.
- Facilitate regular governance meetings with suppliers to review performance, discuss risks, and agree on improvement actions.
- Build strong, collaborative relationships with suppliers to foster a culture of continuous improvement and partnership.

Key challenges

- Being the "go-to" for suppliers while also holding them to account on KPIs, SLAs, and contractual terms

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Risk Management

- Monitor commercial and operational risks related to supplier performance.
 - Maintain a risk register for supplier delivery and escalate systemic risks promptly.
 - Collaborate with PMs and the Commercial and Performance Team to mitigate risks before they impact network performance.
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Relationship management

- Build strong relationships with suppliers and internal stakeholders to manage conflict resolution and facilitate constructive discussions when performance issues arise
 - Support procurement processes for new contracts and variations.
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Zero harm

- Monitor and report on supplier compliance with health and safety requirements and contractual obligations, escalating issues to Project Managers or Contract Administrators as required.
 - Undertake quarterly H&S reviews of key suppliers to ensure compliance with KiwiRail's ACC accreditation.
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Decision Making

The position is accountable for decisions related to supplier performance and for providing advice to relevant stakeholders on matters that impact the effective delivery of the Wellington Metro network.

Key decision-making requirements of the position include:

- Set and maintain the supplier governance cadence (monthly ops review, quarterly exec review) and require attendance and data submissions to agreed deadlines.
- Approve reporting formats and data standards (templates, definitions, timeliness thresholds) for performance.
- Trigger formal escalation pathways when predefined thresholds are breached (e.g., repeated KPI failure, data non-submission, safety leading indicators trending poorly).
- Prioritise performance deep-dives and agree investigation scopes with the Commercial and Performance manager (root cause analyses, independent audits).
