About the Role

Purpose of the role

As the Senior Power BI and Data Control Analyst, you will be responsible for developing and managing our central capital management system in Power BI. Your role will involve both Power BI development and ensuring data is controlled, accurate, and consistent across multiple systems, creating a single, reliable source of project information. You will work closely with teams to securely manage key data, enabling clear and consistent reporting across asset management, workbank delivery and major project reporting.

Your role is crucial in helping KiwiRail make strategic decisions by creating advanced Power BI reports and dashboards. These will offer insights into cost, time, and risk, improving how we track project performance across different systems, including work orders in Maximo, cost allocation in SAP, risks in RiskConnect, and schedules in Primavera P6. You will also manage our Power BI and PowerApp-based Project Status Report (PSR) and improve existing dashboards, ensuring data is integrated and processes run smoothly across the portfolio.

Key Accountabilities

Power BI Development

- Create and maintain advanced Power BI reports and dashboards that provide insights into project costs, timelines, and risks.
- Ensure that reports are user-friendly, have low maintenance overhead, and meet the needs of various stakeholders across the organisation.

Data Integration and Management

- Support the integration of data from multiple systems, including Maximo, SAP, RiskConnect, and Primavera P6, to ensure consistency and accuracy.
- Develop processes to manage critical data and maintain a single source of truth for project information.

Reporting Oversight

- Produce management reports for governance boards and executives that highlight portfolio performance and key insights as well as any data quality issues.
- Manage the recently developed Power BI and PowerApp-enabled Project Status Report (PSR), ensuring it remain fit for purpose for the project teams.

Stakeholder Engagement

- Work closely with cross-functional teams to understand their data needs and ensure reports and dashboards meet those requirements.
- Foster strong relationships with key stakeholders to promote the use of Power BI tools and insights in their decision-making processes.

Continuous Improvement

- Identify opportunities for improving data management processes and reporting efficiency, ensuring that the capital management system evolves to meet business needs.
- Stay updated on Power BI features and best practices, integrating new capabilities to enhance reporting and data analysis.
