



HOMAI RAIL WORKS: 24/7 CONSTRUCTION

May-June 2026

Dear neighbour,

KiwiRail is readying the Auckland rail network to prepare it for the more frequent trains the City Rail Link (CRL) will bring when it opens later this year and to make train travel more resilient and reliable. We are completing construction works in South Auckland, including Homai.

During the King's Birthday long weekend (see dates right), KiwiRail will progress an upgrade of our rail infrastructure near Homai Station. Work will happen day and night to complete it quickly.

Teams will install some new drainage, replace aging sleepers and undertake associated track works. Our teams will use the car park area at Homai Station and areas off McVilly Road and Jutland Road to access the rail corridor. Traffic management will be in place. We will store materials needed for this work at our site in Beatty Ave; please use caution when in these areas.

There will be a full Auckland rail network closure from Saturday 30 May until the end of Monday 1 June 2026.

This project is part of KiwiRail's work to prepare Auckland's rail network for increased services and more frequent trains as part of the CRL.

What we are doing:

This upgrade will improve reliability and allow more frequent trains by installing modern drainage and replacing sleepers and ballast, the rocks the rails sit on.

Night works – what you can expect

We are completing some construction works in your area. During this work there may be noise, dust, vibrations and lights needed to keep the workers safe at night. Our teams are mindful that they are working in residential areas and will do their best to keep the disruption to a minimum. However, despite their efforts this work may cause you some disturbance and we apologise in advance for this.

There will be increased vehicle movements near the Homai Station car park, McVilly Road, Jutland Avenue and Beatty Avenue. We will use these areas for materials storage and to access the rail corridor. Please take extra caution when in the vicinity. Work sites and the access point are marked in the below map:
