

Dear neighbour,

KiwiRail is rebuilding and upgrading Auckland's rail network to make train travel more resilient and reliable and to prepare the network for the more frequent trains the City Rail Link (CRL) will bring when it opens next year. We are continuing a major upgrade of our rail infrastructure in Parnell and Newmarket.

Over the 2025-26 summer rail upgrade (see dates right), we will be upgrading drainage and foundations under the tracks within and on both sides of Parnell Tunnel and making necessary repairs to the tunnel. This work will take place day and night so we can complete it as quickly as possible.

Parnell Station, Cowie Street and Sarawia Street, Newmarket, will be used as access points for our vehicles, so please take extra care when in the vicinity. We will be lifting rails to work beneath them and undertaking associated track works. This can only be undertaken when no trains are running.

There will be a full Auckland rail network closure between 27 December and 18 January; the closure on the Southern Line will extend until 26 January. Testing of the new CRL timetable means the entire network will be closed to passengers on 27–28 January 2026.

What we are doing:

This is part of the Rail Network Rebuild programme to improve reliability, allowing more frequent trains and improving the ride for passengers. The work involves the following steps:

- Removing track, ballast, foundations and drainage throughout the tunnel
- Installation of new drainage, foundations and ballast
- Replacement of all sleepers and reinstalling existing rail
- Installation of new signals cables to improve resilience.

KiwiRail will use this opportunity to undertake other renewal and enabling works to ensure the safety and reliability of the Auckland rail network. To find out more, visit kiwirail.co.nz/aklrailrebuild.




LOCATION OF PARNELL TUNNEL RAIL WORKS
