



## KINGSLAND RAIL CONSTRUCTION WORKS

July 2026

Dear neighbour,

KiwiRail is completing its upgrade of the Auckland rail network in your area to make train travel more resilient and reliable and to prepare for the more frequent trains the City Rail Link will bring when it opens later this year.

**Teams will work near your property during the Matariki long weekend (dates right) to get the work done as safely and quickly as possible.** They will undertake work on the Kingsland scissors near your property which will involve welding and grinding rails.

The worksite is marked in orange in the below map and our team will access the rail corridor near the yellow circle.



There will be a full Auckland rail network closure between 9 and 12 July 2026. Rail passengers are encouraged to check the AT Mobile app or visit the Auckland Transport (AT) website to plan their travel
