

NEWMARKET JUNCTION WORKS

Dear neighbour,

Our teams will be carrying out the replacement of two large, complex pieces of track infrastructure within the Newmarket Triangle, opposite Broadway. This work will take place during the day from **6am - 6pm, 12 April - 27 April**.

As this is a large and complex piece of work, it can only be undertaken when there are no passenger trains running. This means a lot of our access time is limited to nights, weekends, and public holiday periods while the network is closed to passenger trains.

Teams will be accessing the rail corridor via Sarawia Street, The Warehouse carpark and Mauranui Avenue.

What we are doing:

Teams will be undertaking major construction works to replace a critical track junction infrastructure piece that allows the trains to switch tracks.

Teams will be removing track infrastructure, digging new formations, and then replacing the infrastructure with new assets.

This will be intensive work, involving rail grinding and cutting, digging new formations, welding and then placing the new junction. After this is in place, the new diamond will be connected to the existing track infrastructure. Once this has been done, the tamper will then tamp the new ballast into place.

How this affects you:

There will be noise from heavy machinery, bright lights and vehicles moving around.

Our staff and contractors are mindful of our rail neighbours and will work hard to minimise any disturbance, to get this essential work done as quickly and quietly as possible. However, despite their best efforts, this work may cause you some disturbance and we apologise for the inconvenience.




