

WORKS NOTICE

November 2023

Dear neighbour,

Over the next 30 years, it is expected that an extra 130,000 people will call South Auckland home. In preparation for the future growth of the area, the New Zealand Upgrade Programme is funding the development of three new railway stations between Papakura and Pukekohe.

The Drury Rail Stations project is part of the \$1.5 billion investment to improve the resilience and efficiency of rail in Auckland.

What we are doing:


As you may be aware, our upcoming Drury Railway Station is going to be located at the site of 250 Great South Road, Drury. Before construction begins in early 2024, we need to complete some enabling works. We expect this work to begin from Sunday 3 December 2023.

Our contractors, Green Way Ltd, will begin by removing the two properties located at 250 Great South Road. The building removal will begin on Monday 4 December and take approximately eight days to complete.

Once removed, our contractors John Holland will prepare this site for future construction. This involves excavating a section of the site, on both sides of the railway tracks, to prepare for piling works.

We will be installing concrete piles at the locations shown on the image in blue for the station foundations.

The piling works will begin in late December and is expected to be completed in early Autumn 2024.





How this work affects you

Between 3 December 2023 and 14 January 2024, our working hours will be Monday to Sunday, 6am-6pm.

General construction noise and vibrations, along with increased truck movements, should be expected during working hours.

We will work to minimise dust and any disruption as much as possible and monitor our works to ensure they remain within consented limits.

From 15 January 2024, our general working hours will be Sunday to Friday, 6am-6pm. On occasion, we may need to work outside of these hours, but we'll contact you in advance of any scheduled works.

An approved traffic management plan (TMP) will be in place on Great South Road to allow trucks safe access to our site. This will be clearly signposted and will not affect resident/business parking spaces.

An approved TMP will be in place on Flanagan Road. Single lane traffic will be in place for the duration of the works and will be clearly signposted.
