

Dear neighbour,

Each year KiwiRail takes advantage of the quieter holiday period to deliver a large programme of works to improve Auckland's rail network. Our annual block of line will take place between 26 December 2023 to 14 January 2024.

We will be working in multiple locations along the 19km Papakura to Pukekohe electrification route.



What are we doing?

Papakura Station

Works will be underway throughout Papakura Railway Station to test the new overhead line equipment and install new wires.

Between **26 December** and **12 January** our working hours will be between **6am-6pm**. On **13** and **14 January** works will be **24/7**.

During this time, there will be reduced street parking and an approved traffic management plan (TMP) on Railway Street West. All changes will be clearly signposted.

A site office will be set up on our laydown area, located on the corner of Onslow Road and Railway Street West. Truck movements and the use of elevated work platforms should be expected in this area.

Papakura

A **24/7** closure will be in place at the Boundary Road Level Crossing between **28 December 2023** and **4 January 2024**. An approved TMP will be in place and clearly signposted.

Drury

Minor works will be taking place along the railway track between Drury and Sutton Road. Works will take place between **26 December** to **14 January**, **6am-6pm**. High Rail vehicles should be expected during this time.

The Drury Rail Stations project will begin piling works at the location of the upcoming

Drury Rail Station between **3 December** to **14 January, 6am-6pm**. Close neighbours will be contacted directly.

Paerata

Minor works will take place between Crown Road Level Crossing and the Tuhimata Road pedestrian crossing. Works will take place between **26 December** to **14 January**, **6am-6pm**. High Rail vehicles should be expected during this time

Pukekohe

Our Rail Network Rebuild (RNR) team will be working to upgrade the track between 33 Franklin Road, Pukekohe and the Tuhimata Road pedestrian crossing in Paerata. Works will begin at Franklin Road and continue north to Paerata between 19 November to 9 January, 24/7.

The Tamper will be operating between Pukekohe and Tuhimata Road pedestrian crossing between **27-29 December**, **6am-6pm**.

Pukekohe Station

Physical works will continue to take place at Pukekohe Station between 18-22 December and 27 December to 14 January, 7am-6pm.

General construction noise, dust and large vehicle movements should be expected during this time.

We will work to limit the disruption to our neighbours as much as possible.
