

## **TAKANINI – 24/7 MAJOR TRACK WORKS**

October 2025

#### Dear neighbour,

Our teams will be carrying out intensive track works between Taka Street and Manuroa Road over the Labour Weekend rail closure.

This work will take place 24/7 from 6am Friday 24 October to 6pm Monday 27 October.

As this is a large piece of work, it can only be undertaken when there are no passenger trains running. This means a lot of our access time is limited to nights, weekends, and public holiday periods while the network is closed to passenger trains.

Thank you for your on-going patience as we continue to undertake maintenance and upgrade works on the rail network near your property

#### What we are doing:

We will be replacing existing rail. This will be intensive work involving rail grinding, cutting and welding.

Teams will be cutting and removing existing rail, replacing it with new rail and finally welding the new rail together and grinding it to the correct shape.

Much of the noisy work needs to be done at night, when the temperatures are cooler, and we apologise in advance for the disruption this may cause.

### How this affects you:

There will be noise from heavy machinery, bright lights and vehicles moving around.

Our staff and contractors are mindful of our rail neighbours and will work hard to minimise any disturbance, to get this essential work done as quickly and quietly as possible. However, despite their best efforts, this work may cause you some disturbance and we apologise for the inconvenience.

Please note, as part of Auckland Transport's Takanini Level Crossing project, engineers will also be carrying out investigation works during the day within the rail corridor as they plan for the new bridges to replace level crossings in the area.
